IN A CIVIL CASE**

 JURY VERDICT. This action came before the Court for a trial by jury. The issues have been tried and the jury has rendered its verdict.

 X **DECISION BY COURT.** This action came to trial or hearing before the Court. The issues have been tried or heard and a decision has been rendered.

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that

1. AS 15.13.070(b)(2) is constitutional to the extent that an individual may contribute not more than \$5,000 per year to a political party for the purpose of nominating or electing a candidate. To the extent that donations to political parties that are made for a purpose

other than influencing the nomination or election of a candidate are restricted, AS 15.13.070(b)(2) and AS 15.30.400(3) are unconstitutional;

2. The provision in AS 15.13.400(B)(i) restricting or limiting volunteering professional services is unconstitutional; and,
3. AS 15.13.074(f) is constitutional to the extent that it prohibits a corporation, company, partnership, firm, association, organization, business trust or surety, labor union, or publicly funded entity from making a contribution to a political party for the purpose of nominating or electing a candidate. AS 15.13.074(f) does not prohibit, and is unconstitutional to the extent that it prohibits, contributions by these entities to a political party for a purpose other than influencing the nomination or election of a candidate.

Defendants are hereby enjoined from enforcing any of the unconstitutional portions of 48 SLA 1996.


