## U.S. Senate Confirms (One) Judicial Nominee, Begins Filibuster Against Another and Continues Obstructionism Against Miguel Estrada

As the obstructionist filibuster against D.C. Circuit Court of Appeals nominee Miguel Estrada continues -- and another begins against Fifth Circuit nominee Priscilla Owen -- the United States Senate this week confirmed, by a vote of 52 to 41, the nomination of Jeffrey Sutton to the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit.

Like Estrada and Owen, Sutton's nomination was stalled in confirmation limbo for nearly two years. Like Estrada and Owen, his confirmation is opposed by radical special interest groups that have hijacked the judicial confirmation process. In fact, while Sutton's confirmation is a step in the right direction, a simple comparison of the three nominees' experience and situation further begs the question of why a majority of Senate Democrats will not allow the nominations of Miguel Estrada and Priscilla Owen to proceed to an up-or-down vote by the full Senate, as prescribed by the U.S. Constitution.
